ANTI-DUMPING NOTICE NO 2023/067

A4 copy paper

Exported to Australia from multiple countries

Findings in Relation to Revocation Reviews

Nos 622, 623, 624 and 625

Notice under section 269ZDB(1) of the Customs Act 1901

The Commissioner of the Anti-Dumping Commission has completed 4 reviews, which commenced on 5 May 2023, of the anti-dumping measures applying to A4 copy paper (the goods) exported to Australia from the Federative Republic of Brazil (Brazil), the People's Republic of China (China), Finland, the Republic of Indonesia (Indonesia), the Republic of Korea (ROK), the Russian Federation (Russia), the Slovak Republic (Slovakia) and the Kingdom of Thailand (Thailand) (collectively, the subject countries).

Recommendations resulting from those reviews, reasons for the recommendations and material findings of fact and law in relation to the reviews are contained in *Anti-Dumping Commission Report Nos 622, 623, 624 & 625 (REP 622-625)*.

I, ED HUSIC, Minister for Industry and Science, have considered REP 622-625 and have decided to accept the recommendations and reasons for the recommendations, including all the material findings of facts or law set out in REP 622-625.

Under section 269ZDB(1)(a)(ii) of the *Customs Act 1901* (the Act), I DECLARE, for the purposes of the Act and the *Customs Tariff (Anti-Dumping) Act 1975* (Dumping Duty Act) and with effect from **5 May 2023**, that the dumping duty notices and countervailing duty notice currently applying to A4 copy paper exported to Australia from the subject countries are taken to have been revoked in relation to exporters generally.

Interested parties may seek a review of this decision by lodging an application with the Anti-Dumping Review Panel (www.adreviewpanel.gov.au) in accordance with the requirements in Division 9 of Part XVB of the Act, within 30 days of the publication of this notice.


